### TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

1. The Month of September: We welcome you all to the month of September, the ninth month of the year which notably brings the Third Quarter of the year to an end. This month ushers us into the "ember" months which reminds us that the year is gradually coming to an end and the need to examine the progress made thus far especially in our Christian journey. In our Archdiocese, the month of September leads us into a period of Harvest. This period offers us the opportunity to thank God with the best fruits of our labour for His abiding love, faithfulness and blessings upon us. We pray that the Lord of the harvest will accept our gifts as He accepted the gift of His servant, Abel the just.

In this month, the Church in her wisdom presents to her faithful, feasts which assist us to understand and appreciate the paschal mystery of Our Lord Jesus Christ. These feasts include; the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary on September 8 and the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross on September 14. The Nativity of Mary marks the beginning of the unraveling of God's plan of salvation for his people, while the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, which is the patron feast day of our Archdiocese, brings to completion the mission of God's plan for his people on the Cross. By his death on the cross, Christ destroyed their enmity; by means of the cross he united both races into one body and brought them back to God. (Eph. 2:16).

2. CONCERN FOR OUR COUNTRY NIGERIA: The situation of things in our country is desperate and as we continue to challenge government to institute good governance, fairness and equity, we call on our lay faithful in their different formations to also exercise their rights as citizens of the nation as they engage in party politics so as to bring the values of the faith to bear on the way things are run. We encourage the study of the Social Teaching of the Church by the lay faithful in their associations so that it can be a guide in making their voices heard on issues that affect the welfare the country, the Church and all citizens.

As we do what we can, we need to also call down divine intervention. This is why we called for prayers in the midst of the difficulties facing our country at this time. (a.) We must continue the **Prayer for Nigeria in Distress** in parishes at all Masses; those who have stopped should resume saying the prayers with attention and devotion. (b) Parish Priests and Priests-incharge should organize adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and benediction on Sundays, specifically in supplication for the unity, safety and security of the peoples of our country. (c) in addition, we also ask that individuals and families should also pray the rosary daily for the same intention.

We urge the entire faithful of the Archdiocese in each parish to participate in this prayer. To this effect, we ask Parish Priests to ensure that the faithful are deliberately encouraged to participate in the prayers. People should not be holding meetings when prayers are being offered in such a desperate situation that we have found ourselves as if it does not concern them. We, however, urge members of the Marian Societies, the Association of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Apostleship of Prayer, St. Jude and St. Rita to make participation at these prayer sessions their special obligation at this time, interceding on behalf of the nation.

- 3. COMMUNIQUE OF THE CBCN MEETING-ENUGU 2021: The Catholic Bishops Conference of Nigeria having just concluded its second plenary meeting for the year at Enugu from 19 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 issued a communique to the catholic faithful and all people of goodwill in the country. The communique is available on the Archdiocesan website: lagosarchdiocese.org We encourage everyone to read the communique in full. The following are some of the highlights:
  - The increasing insecurity and violence in the land have made life to become so cheap in our country.
  - Death in the hands of kidnappers, killer herdsmen, bandits, terrorist groups have made Nigeria one of the most terrorized countries in the world.
  - The government must do more by taking full responsibility for the present culture of violence and impunity in the country and show more strategic commitment and sincerity in this fight against insecurity and violence.

- The Eucharist remains central to the life of the Church; as such should be celebrated with untainted faith, deep love and manifest devotion.
- We should always take care that monetary matters do not distract or detract the people from the solemnity of the celebration.
- Priests are encouraged to show and grow their commitment to the Eucharist.
  They are to celebrate the Eucharist as "servants" of the mystery and not
  "masters" of it. As servants, priests are called to refrain from adding or
  subtracting from the approved Missal for mass.
- On October 1 every year, parishes all over the country are expected to hold a candlelight procession and pray twenty decades of the rosary for peace and unity of our country.
