TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

- 1. THE MONTH OF APRIL: Welcome to the month of April, 2022, a month that leads us into the special season of Easter. This season begins with the celebration of the Resurrection of our saviour and redeemer Jesus Christ, the climax of the Holy Week celebrations. In this month, these remarkable events leading to the mystery of our salvation are celebrated: Palm Sunday (April 10th), Holy Thursday (April 14th), Good Friday (April 15th), Holy Saturday (April 16th), Easter Sunday (April 17th). Throughout the entire month, the Church continues to celebrate the joy of Easter and the gift of New Life in Christ. Though the way to the Resurrection was the Via Crucis, the Sacrificial Lamb of God is now and forever Christ our Light, the eternal High Priest of the New Covenant. And his sorrowful mother, the Stabat Mater of Good Friday, is now the jubilant Regina Caeli.
- 2. EASTER: The word "Easter" is a derivative from the Old English meaning the, "East." The sun which rises in the East, bringing light, warmth and hope, is a symbol for the Christian of the rising Christ, who is the true Light of the world. The Paschal Candle is a central symbol of this divine light, which is Christ. It is kept near the ambo throughout Easter Time, and lit for all liturgical celebrations. Easter is also the celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and the sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. Easter Time is the most important of all liturgical times. There are 50 days of Easter from the first Sunday to Pentecost. It is characterized, above all, by the joy of glorified life and victory over death, expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian: Alleluia! All other expressions of faith flow from faith in the resurrection: "If Christ has not

been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith." (1 Cor 15:14) The octave of Easter comprises the eight (8) days which stretch from the first to the second Sunday. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. In a sense, every day of the Octave is like a little Sunday. Easter is the feast of feasts, the unalloyed joy and gladness of all Christians. This truly is "the day that the Lord has made." From Sunday to Sunday, from year to year, the celebrations of Easters in this world will lead us to that blessed day on which Christ has promised that He will come again in glory to take us with Him into the kingdom of His Father. May this Easter bring us good tidings and heavenly blessings.

- 3. MASS OF THE CHRISM 2022: This will take place on Tuesday 12th April and Thursday 14th April, 2022. Venue: Catholic Church of the Nativity, Festac Town and Holy Cross Cathedral respectively, Time: 9:00am. In preparation for the 2022 Chrism Mass, all Parish priests are to pay the sum of N50,000 to their respective Deans who are in turn to remit the money as a Deaneries to the Planning Committees.
- 4. CATHEDRATICUM- One of the very laudable practices at the Masses of Chrism is the presentation of gifts that are distributed to the less-privileged and the needy in various Homes and prisons around the Archdiocese. We expect Parish Priests and Priests-In-Charge to make deliberate and concerted efforts to encourage Parishioners to generously donate gift items to the growing number of indigent people that come around with high expectations at this time. The resources saved by our Lenten fast are supposed to be used for charity rather than as savings for other personal uses.
- **5**. A Few Thoughts **on Lenten Observances**: As we continue the season of lent, we hereby remind everyone of the following regarding the season:
- a. Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age and above are required to abstain totally from meat or favorite dish or drink on Good Friday (April 15) and all the Fridays of Lent.
- b. **Fasting**: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 60 years are obliged to fast. In practice, fasting involves limiting oneself to a single full meal or two smaller meals a day. Those who are sick, pregnant or nursing or whose health would adversely be affected by fasting should not consider themselves bound by this norm.

c. Parents and teachers are responsible for helping young persons, who are not bound by the norms regarding fasting and abstinence to recognize the value of genuine acts of penance and self-denial.

We are also required to pray fervently for the catechumens who will receive the Sacraments of Initiation during this period.

- d. Please find below some of the other ways we can observe this period of Lent in order to receive the graces of the season in full:
- i. Avoid Sin: Keep yourself away from all occasions that could lead to sin. If you fall into sin, repent and return to God by receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, doing appropriate penance and making a firm resolution not to fall into sin again.
- ii. Practice Charity; be more generous especially in giving to the poor and needy and in contributing to the works of the church, remission of debts and payment of just wages.
- iii. Pursue and achieve **reconciliation** with anyone with whom you are not at peace or with whom you have a guarrel of misunderstanding.
- iv. Read the Scriptures in order to deepen your intimacy with God, spread the kingdom of Christ and help others to know and return to Christ.
- v. Pray your **Rosary** daily.

Bear in mind that all other Fridays of the year remain Days of penance in prayerful remembrance of the passion of Jesus Christ.
