TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

- 1. THE MONTH OF MAY: A warm welcome to the month of May to everyone. In this month, the Church specially draws attention to the mother of the Risen Lord who stood beside her son in his Passion and on the cross and now shares in his glory having been conferred with the title of Regina Caeli i.e., Queen of heaven. During the entire month of May, which coincides with the Easter time, the Church echoes the Regina Caeli among her prayers as we pray: "O! Queen of Heaven rejoice...... Alleluia ... for the Lord has risen indeed", WE relish the joy that Mary shares with her Son in his triumphant Resurrection. By adoptive Sonship, we also, in a most profound way are made partakers in the joy of the Resurrection; we participate in the fullness of life that Christ offers. May Christ's resurrection by which heaven is wedded to earth and reconciled God with Man be our eternal hope and reward.
- 2. SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD: This comes up on Thursday 26th of May 2022. The solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord marks the day when we Christians commemorate Our Lord's glorious entry into heaven, body and soul. It is officially celebrated on the 40th day of Easter. Forty Days after the resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Acts of the Apostles records Jesus' ascension into heaven. The origin of the feast of Ascension dates back to 4th century AD. In some parts of the world, the celebration of the feast is transferred to the Sunday after the traditional day. The Ascension feast attests to the reality of the person of Jesus; true God and true man, returning to the Father in order to come again at the Second Coming. Our faith teaches us that meanwhile, He sits at the right hand of God the Father until He comes to judge the living and the dead. By the feast of the Ascension, may our eyes be turned towards heaven where our true treasure lies.

- 4. ON THE NEED FOR MORE ATTENTIVE PARENTING: Sometime in April this year, some children of a school in Lagos were involved in an indecent sexual activity during the course of their trip overseas at which they represented their school at an international event in Dubai. They filmed the act and uploaded it on the social network. The matter has generated social media outrage and sparked conversations around parenting.

We wish to use this medium to encourage parents to pay more special attention to the emotional needs of their children given the general atmosphere of moral laxity that we are experiencing in our country as in other parts of the world. Parents must give more quality time to listen to their children, gain their confidence and pay attention to the influences that they are being exposed to.

We are in an era in which the use of devices such as smart phones, televison sets, sophisiticated computers and tablets have become an imperative for education and entertainment. Parents must therfore ensure that they devise means of monitoring what the materials their children are exposed to and restrict them from access to inappropriate and immoral sites. The technological devices of our children should be restricted to educational sites only. Indeed, we advise parents not to purchase devices that are way beyond the minimum their children require for educational purposes.

We know that parenting is not an easy task, it has never been but we must make more efforts. May God continue to bless our efforts as parents and guide our children to growth in moral values and holiness of life. Amen.

5. ARCHDIOCESAN SEMINAR FOR PRIESTS ON BOOK VI OF THE CODE OF CANON LAW: At the Curia meeting of the Archdiocese held recently, it was agreed that the Seminar for Priests scheduled for the month of June will be dedicated to a study of the Book VI of the Code of Canon Law and it shall take place simultaneously in four regions within the Archdiocese as follows:

Venues:

IKEJA AND LAGOS REGIONS: St. Agnes Catholic Church, Maryland.

BADAGRY REGION: Holy Family Catholic Church, Festac Town.

We appeal to the Episcopal Vicars and the Deans to help ensure the smooth planning of this seminars.

6. LEADING FOR MISSION SEMINAR: The Catholic Archdiocese of Lagos began the Leading for Mission Seminar for all priests in 2019 since when over 80% of the clergy completed the leadership enhancement programme. There is an annual opportunity for new and remaining priests to complete the programme. The Leading for Mission Seminar for lay leaders began in July 2021 and is ongoing.

It has become necessary to clarify that going forward:

1. It is mandatory that anyone that is elected, selected, appointed, or otherwise assumes a leadership position at the parish, deanery and archdiocesan levels

- completes the training within six months or steps down for those that have completed the programme.
- 2. All current leaders, whose tenures will not expire this year, have until the end of 2022 to complete the training, or step down for those that have completed the programme.

The Archdiocese is putting in a lot of resources into the training of lay leaders and it has become necessary that we all pull together to maximize our limited resources. There are an estimated 15,000 lay leaders that need to be trained. Some Deans and Parish Priests have been supporting our efforts by providing training halls, power, equipment, refreshments, and other materials while the Leading for Mission volunteers continue to sacrifice their time, talents, and material resources, to achieve our goal of having leaders empowered for their roles by adequate training in our Archdiocese. We are very grateful to them. We are requesting that the Volunteers and those to be trained should be provided with all necessary support.

In order to make training easier, from now on we have decided that rather than going to a parish centre in each deanery for the training:

- 1. All parishes with a minimum of 50 lay leaders are to organize and mobilize all their leaders to be trained by the LFM Team in the premises of their parishes. We expect the Deans to work with the LFM Team and Parish Priests to come up with a schedule that completes the training of all parishes in one year. Parish Priests and the Parish Laity Council executives in each parish will provide the required logistics.
- 2. The Deans and Deanery Laity Councils and the Archdiocesan Laity Council and the Director of the Lay Apostolate Centre are to coordinate the trainings in the deanery level and Archdiocesan levels respectively. We expect the training of the leaders at each level to be completed within one year.
- 3. We expect everyone concerned to support the timely and smooth completion of this programme by suspending or at least minimizing programmes targeted at the same group or running at the same time as LFM Seminars so that we can conclude this intensive stage successfully.

We are grateful to Deans and Parish Priests and ask them to continue to playing their assigned roles so we can achieve our goals of growing more engaged parishes and

spiritually- committed Catholics in the Archdiocese. May God bless you as you contribute to developing more spiritually-committed servant leaders for our common task of evangelization.
