TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

1. THE MONTH OF AUGUST: I heartily welcome you all to the month of August 2022. This month is another significant month in the life of the Church and State. It offers us the opportunity to rest and examine the growth we have attained during the earlier part of the year and to strategize on how to spend the remaining part of the year very well. Farmers at this time rest after the tedious season of planting awaiting harvest.

Two important celebrations in the life of the Church this month are; the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord Jesus Christ (Aug. 6) and the Assumption of Our Blessed Virgin Mary (Aug. 15). As Christians, these two great feasts draw our attention to the mystery of the beatific vision which we look forward to having after our earthly sojourn. At the Transfiguration, Our Lord Jesus Christ revealed his glorified self to the three Apostles who were with him on Mount Tabor, giving them a foretaste of heaven. The Solemnity of the Assumption enlivens in us the hope that, like Our Blessed Mother who was assumed into heaven with her glorified body, we too will one day become partakers of the heavenly banquet.

- St. Augustine whose memorial we also celebrate this month amongst others, realizing at his late conversion the *magnum laetitia* of the heavenly banquet exclaimed with remorse "Late have I loved you O Beauty so Ancient and so New, Late have I loved you; you called, you cried, you rid me of my deafness." Dear friends, let us like St. Augustine examine our lives so far in this period of the year that offers us rest, and return with deep remorse to our maker, if we have strayed far away from Him, so that we may be partakers of the Eschatological Union.
- 2. SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION: This holy day of Obligation is celebrated on the 15th of August every year, is one of the four dogmas of the Church on the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Church teaches in this dogma, that our mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, preserved

from the stain of original sin and having completed the course of her earthly life, was by the power of God taken into heaven body and soul, since her spotless body cannot be allowed to suffer the corruption of the grave. The Assumption of Our Blessed Virgin Mary was declared a dogma by the Apostolic Constitution of Pope Pius XXII in the year 1950. Let us like Mary strive towards perfection and holiness of life so that we may merit eternal happiness.

3. SPECIAL COLLECTION FOR ST. AUGUSTINE REGIONAL PASTORAL INSTITUTE, EDE (SARPI).
