TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

1. The Month of June: Come O! Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of your Faithful and enkindle in them the Fire of your Love, with these words of prayer I heartily welcome you to the month of June, 2019. This month leads us from the joys of Easter to an anticipation of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, a revival of the Spirit of God which we all received at our Baptism and Confirmation. In the spirit of St. Paul's advice to Timothy, we remind ourselves to fan into a flame the gifts of God which we received from the Holy Spirit at our Baptism and Confirmation.

Having come to the beginning of the second half of the year in this month, we need to evaluate how far we have fared in keeping the resolutions that we made at the beginning of the year. It is also important for us to examine how we have responsded or not to the promptings of the Holy Spirit through the proper use of the gifts He has given us.

During this month, we shall celebrate such remarkable feasts as th Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity 16th June, Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ 23rd June, and the Solemnity of Ss. Peter & Paul 29th June. May we be built up in the practice of our faith as we celebrate these treasuries of faith.

2. Leadership Training for Priests: while we continue to be grateful to God for the success of the first batch of the Leadership Training for Priests, we announce the commencement of the second batch and we call on all Priests enlisted for the second batch to take full advantage of this unique opportunity for growth, to attend PUNCTUALLY and participate ACTIVELY in the sessions. The dates for the Second Batch of 25 Priests are as follows:

Module 1 - May 29th and 30th 2019

Module 2 - June 26th and 27th

Module 3 - July 24th and 25th

Module 4 - September 25th and 26th

- 3. Collating the number of Scholarships for Augustine University offered so far: For some time now, we have been repeating the item concerning support for Augustine University in our monthly circular. At this time, we call on those parishes and individuals who have offered scholarships to give the information to the office of the Director of Education. Kindly inform the Directorate of the the name(s) of students being sponsored, the year the sponsorship began and the course of study. We once again appeal to Parishes to offfer schlarships to young people in their parishes who are from indigent homes but are brilliant and have admission to the University. We ask all Priests and the lay faithful to keep this request in mind.
- 4. Augustine University offers Preliminary Studies: Having obtained her Permanent License, the Augustine University, in collaboration with the Government Body responsible for Preliminary Studies in Nigeria, would soon be offering opportunities to do Preliminary Studies to students in a University environment. This opportunity is for young people who sat for JAMB Exam but did not secure admission or those who are awaiting their results. The advantage for those who do the Preliminary Studies is that they will be able to go on straight to 200level of their programme of studies in the uiversity. For more information about this, interested persons should contact the University or the Directorate of Education.
- 5. Study Sessions for Priests on the Archdiocesan Youth Policy: We launched the Archdiocesan Youth Policy since August 2018. We hereby reaffirm the need that Parish Priests and others concerned with the implementation should do the needful in ensuring that the Policy fulfills the purpose for which so much effort was expended in order to publish. We expect that Deans in discussion with the Episcopal Vicars will organise Study Sessions on the Policy with the aim of assuring that the Priests are familiar with the content of the Policy. We expect the Deanery Youth Chaplains to be the arrow-heads in preparing the Study Sessions. We expect that these sessions should take place by the last Quarter of this year, 2019.

Let us all remember that care of the Youth is of paramount importance and cannot be left to chance. The Policy is a proactive effort to take deliberate steps to form the youths and give them the tools they need in order to lead the Church with commitment into the future. Let us always remember that any group of people who do not form their youth are jeorpadising the future.

- 6. Admission Requirements into St. Augustine College of Education, (Project T.I.M.E): We call on Parish Priests and Priests-in-Charge to inform their Parishioners that the abovenamed College has commenced admission procedures for its 2018/2019 session. Admission requirements include:
- (a) A minimum JAMB Score of 200 and above for Degree programmes and 100 and above for NCE Programmes & OND.
- (B) Available Programmes and their requirements include:

University of Ibadan Degree (Full-Time and Distance Learning Centre) - 5 Credits at one sitting

OR

NCE (Full-Time and Part-Time) - 6 Credits at two sittings.

PDE (PGDE)- First Degree or H.N.D. from any recognized tertiary institution

Catechesis- Practicing and intending Catechists and O' Level Certificate.

I. Mass Wine & Quarterly Returns Booklets: We have received a new supply of Mass Wine. Given the rise in the cost of importation and other logistics, the price has increased also. Parishes can now buy Mass wine from the Chancery at #19,500:00 per carton. In a similar vein, the new Quarterly Returns Booklets are now available in the Chancery at #1,500:00 per booklet.
