TO ALL PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS WORKING IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LAGOS, AND THE LAY FAITHFUL

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

1. THE MONTH OF OCTOBER: Welcome to the month of October, the tenth month of the year which ushers us to the beginning of the fourth quarter. The month of October is dedicated to Our Lady of the Holy Rosary and the Solemnity of Our Lady, Queen and Patroness of Nigeria. During this month, the Church invites us to rededicate ourselves to the maternal patronage of our Mother through the praying of the Holy Rosary as part of our October Devotion. All the faithful are therefore expected to participate, both at the Parish and family level, in the activities of October Devotion. Anyone who prays the Rosary every day with faith and a deep sense of devotion in contrast to mere mechanical and superficial recitation stands to receive divine favour and protection.

Also, in this month, we celebrate the 63rd Independence Anniversary of our beloved country. Let us seize the opportunity that the month of October offers, to pray for our country, Nigeria in these trying times; for economic stability, the triumph of justice, peace, reconciliation, progress and good governance. In doing so, we shall receive spiritual enrichment from Our Lady's maternal intercession. May Our Lady of the Holy Rosary pray for us.

Other feast days and memorials in this month are: The Guardian Angels (October 2), St. Francis of Assisi (October 4), Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7), St. Ignatius of Antioch (October 17), St. Luke (October 18), SS John de Brebeuf and Isaac Jogues and Companions (October 19), and Ss. Simon and Jude (October 28).

- 2. POPE'S INTENTION FOR OCTOBER 2023: For the Synod: We pray for the Church, that she may adopt listening and dialogue as a lifestyle at every level, and allow herself to be guided by the Holy Spirit towards the peripheries of the world.
- 3. ARCHBISHOP'S INTENTION FOR OCTOBER 2023: For Development in Nigeria: May God grant us the desired development in our nation and keep us united as one nation.
- 4. ON PHOTOGRAPH-TAKING ON THE SANCTUARY: The Sanctuary is a holy place, a sacred space within the Sacred Space that the church building is. We, therefore, expect that it should not be turned to a photo-shoot place, used after every liturgical ceremony, such as weddings, baptism, funeral masses, etc. If any photographs at all would be taken, they should be done as exceptions and never the rule, and people must not be allowed to shoot around on the sanctuary on which the altar of sacrifice is located.
